
Validation Scope:

The Rainforest Alliance has validated that the **ECOTRUST – Trees for Global Benefit** project is in compliance with the *Plan Vivo Standards, 2008 June 2008*. This independent third-party validation covers the afforestation project including 258 hectares of privately owned farmlands with planted native and naturalized trees located within the boundaries of the Bushenyi District in Southwestern Uganda. The project intends to achieving removals of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere over 20 years of approximately 53,514 t CO₂.
